Award Criteria Individual

This Award seeks to recognise an individual who has achieved outstanding success in a professional capacity within the Cleaning or Security Industries. This award is open to all employees engaged in providing an operational service to clients. Must be engaged by a BSCAA Member Company.

Award Criteria Company

This award recognises a company which has established the most outstanding training culture and best practices throughout its organisation with the focus on employees. Must be a BSCAA Member Company.

Award Criteria Manager

These Awards encourage the recognition of leadership and management excellence within the building services sector, and to support the professional development of a manager who has demonstrated outstanding commitment and whose performance as a leader and manager is in the opinion of the selection panel worthy of special recognition.

Nominees must hold a Managerial or Supervisory position and have been employed in the industry for at least 2 years. Must be engaged by a BSCAA Member Company.

Award Criteria **CC®Clean**
